HOW TO MAKE THE CALIPER

1. Tape or glue right and left caliper arm templates against cardboard.
2. Cut along the dotted lines.
3. Slightly overlap the arms and attach with a paperclip so that it looks like this:

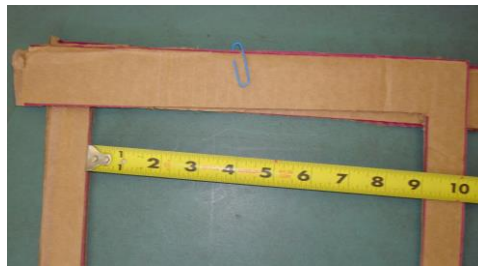

HOW TO MEASURE WITH A CALIPER

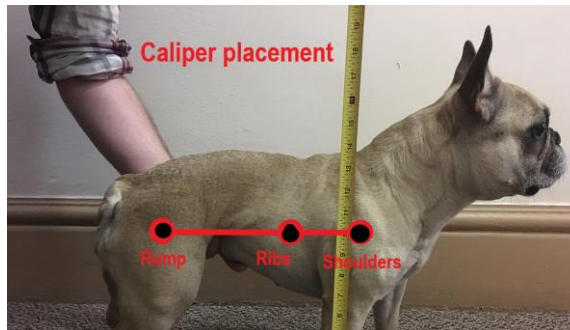
1. Hold the cardboard caliper over your pet's shoulders and slide the arms so it barely touches the pet. You will need to move and adjust the paperclip to keep the arms together. Allow a $\frac{1}{4}$ " space between the points of the caliper and your pet.



2. Using a ruler or metal measuring tape, measure the **inside** of the right and left arms of the caliper.



3. Note the measurement for the shoulders, and repeat for ribs and rump.
